If No, please list any local job possibilities:	I work part-time as a handyman, which also provides many opportunities for witnessing and counseling. An intern could work with me if desired (and would be paid hourly) and get experience in both practical and ministry tasks. Or, there are always part-time jobs available in town, such as the local ice cream shop, gas station, etc.
Additional information:	<p>Our town has about 1,000 people, many of whom are retirees (hence the need for handyman work). During the summer, the population increases as summer residents arrive. We're 15 miles from a town of 5,000, which is also where most of our church people live. We're 45 minutes from several larger towns where we go for shopping or activities.</p> <p>Our church is 170 years old, and has 30-40 people of varying ages, but there are more older people than younger. So, we have very few helpers for things like summer Bible clubs for kids, our town's Fish Days event (where we provide the kids' activities), and other church ministries. By next summer, we are hoping to have a storefront location in town where we can offer many other ministries and try to meet more needs in our town. An intern would have extra opportunities there, depending on how the Lord allows us to work out that vision!</p>
