

2025 Illinois Conference FAQs

1. What does the registration fee include?
 - Registration includes lunches, suppers, snacks, and conference materials.
2. What if I have dietary restrictions?
 - Because area churches donate all of our meals, we are unable to accommodate special diet requests.
3. Are children permitted at the conference?
 - While families are important to us, this conference is for pastors and spouses. As a courtesy to our other participants, we ask that no children attend with you. (Even as we say that, you will see children at the conference. Our RHMA missionaries come as families and you'll occasionally see those MKs around the building doing homework or heading out for activities!)
4. Is there a dress code?
 - There is no specific code. Most pastors and spouses dress casually.
5. I can't attend the entire conference. May I register for one day?
 - Call the RHMA office for one-day registration information (866-263-2350).
